

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES  
(PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 10, EAGLESCLIFFE)  
PUBLIC PATH EXTINUISHMENT ORDER 2023**

**SECTION 118 OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

The above Order was made on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2023. The effect of the Order will be to extinguish the public footpath, known as Public Footpath No 10, running from the rear of 10 Dinsdale Drive, Eaglescliffe, at grid reference 4249 1407, running through the curtilage of Eaglescliffe Golf Club to the green keeper's hut at grid reference 4266,1436 as shown on the Order map (drawing reference H117-297).

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal office hours and on the council's website (Traffic Orders). Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at the price of £1.

Any representation about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to Highway Manager, Community Services, Environment and Culture Directorate, Municipal Buildings, Church Road, Stockton on Tees, TS18 1LD not later than 21<sup>st</sup> December 2023. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representation or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
